In the past two months we have had at least ten churches take us on for support and **we are now at 73% pledged support.** Praise God for his goodness to us and thank you to all the churches who have partnered with us to Serve God's Servants!

We began January presenting our ministry at Mid-County Baptist Church in Nederland, TX and doing a couple day project with them – putting another doorway in their fellowship hall and helping them paint it as well. God blessed our time with them. We also were able to help Church planter Stephen Childers in Malden, MO in February with tearing out some sheetrock out of several rooms. It is amazing to see God guide our steps on this journey – sometimes even with cancellations and rescheduling we know our lives are in the hands of a loving Heavenly Father.

Please pray for our upcoming trip to Alaska in May and June. We will be assisting Job Hale in the Bethel region, Bro. Pinnix with Remote Alaska Missions, and church planter Kevin Baker in the Anchorage area as well as have the opportunity to present Serving God's Servants in multiple churches there. What wonderful opportunities we have when we just surrender to God's will for us to serve! More and more opportunities are presenting themselves to serve and we pray for God's direction!
